

Corporate Volunteer & Engagement Opportunities

Your team can become part of the second chances the Pennsylvania SPCA makes possible every day. The Pennsylvania SPCA and Main Line Animal Rescue offer corporate volunteer experiences across our four locations: our Erie Avenue headquarters in Philadelphia, Main Line Animal Rescue in Phoenixville, and our centers in Lancaster and Danville. Each location offers a different window into our work and different opportunities for teams to engage.

Our corporate experiences are designed to connect employees to our work through service, education, and impact. **Volunteer opportunities are offered based on the current needs of our animals, facilities, and teams, ensuring that each project fills a meaningful need for the organization.** When opportunities are available, we work to match them with the size of your team and your company's goals for the experience.

Each experience is paired with a corporate donation that helps make our work possible, from caring for animals in our shelters, hospitals, and clinics to supporting the lifesaving work of our Animal Law Enforcement team.

CORPORATE VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCE

Up to 15 participants | \$3,000+ donation

A hands-on experience for smaller teams looking for a deeper connection to the PSPCA and the animals we serve. Depending on current needs and location, your experience may include a brief behind-the-scenes tour, introduction to the PSPCA's work, and a hands-on volunteer project.

Projects may include preparing enrichment for shelter animals (e.g. stuffing peanut butter Kongs), organizing supplies, assembling adoption or foster materials, supporting our community outreach programs, or tackling another priority identified by our team.

Your partnership at work:

A \$3,000 donation can make an immediate difference for animals in our care. It could help provide veterinary exams, vaccines, medications, diagnostic testing, food, enrichment, and other essential care for a group of animals arriving at one of our shelters, or help offset the significant cost of caring for an animal requiring more intensive medical treatment.

CORPORATE TEAM EXPERIENCE

16–30 participants | \$6,000+ donation

Designed for larger teams looking to work together on a meaningful project while gaining a deeper understanding of the scale and breadth of the PSPCA's work. **Experiences can take place at one of our PSPCA locations or, depending on the project, we can bring the service experience directly to your workplace.**

For experiences hosted at the PSPCA, the day may include a welcome and impact briefing, facility tours in small groups where appropriate, and a team-based service project designed around a current organizational need.

Projects may include large-scale enrichment preparation, assembling materials for adopters or foster families, preparing community outreach kits, completing a facility improvement project such as painting, or another hands-on project where your team can make a tangible difference for our animals and the communities we serve.

Your partnership at work:

A \$6,000 donation can help underwrite the care of animals arriving at the PSPCA following cruelty or neglect, helping cover a forensic veterinary assessment, treatment, medications, nutrition, shelter, enrichment, and the ongoing care they need as they recover and move toward what comes next.

SIGNATURE CORPORATE SERVICE DAY

30+ participants | \$15,000+ donation

Our Signature Corporate Service Day is a highly customized experience designed in partnership with your company around your employee engagement, team-building, community impact, and corporate social responsibility goals.

Together, we will build an experience that connects your employees to the work of the PSPCA while addressing a meaningful organizational need. The day combines service, education, team building, and philanthropy, giving employees the opportunity to work together in a different way, build camaraderie and connection, and see firsthand the collective impact they can make.

Signature Service Days may take place at a PSPCA location, your corporate office, or another appropriate location depending on the size of the group, goals for the day, and nature of the project.

A Signature Service Day may include:

- A customized welcome and introduction to the PSPCA's work and impact
- A PSPCA-led team experience designed to ground participants in the day's purpose, build connection across the group, and introduce the work happening at the host location and across our four sites and Animal Law Enforcement program
- A customized large-scale service or facility project tied to a current PSPCA priority
- Multiple volunteer stations or activities designed to engage employees in different ways
- Assembly of enrichment, shelter, foster, adoption, or community outreach materials
- Opportunities to hear directly from PSPCA staff about the animals, programs, and communities their work is supporting
- Corporate recognition and opportunities to share the experience and impact with employees

Because every Signature Service Day is built around the company, the group, and the PSPCA's current needs, the format and number of participants can be flexible. Our team will work with you to determine the right scale, location, activities, and structure to create an experience that is meaningful for your employees and valuable to the PSPCA.

Your partnership at work:

A \$15,000+ donation can make a significant investment in some of the PSPCA's most urgent and resource-intensive work, from caring for animals rescued through complex cruelty and neglect cases to providing advanced medical treatment, supporting our Animal Law Enforcement officers in the field, and ensuring our teams have the resources to respond when animals need us most.
